CLASS PLAINTIFFS’ PROPOSAL TO
DISTRIBUTE REMAINING
SETTLEMENT FUNDS FOR
ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION**

1 Before the Court is Class Plaintiffs' Proposal to Distribute Remaining Settlement Funds
2 for Environmental Remediation.

3 WHEREAS the Court granted Plaintiffs' Motion for Final Approval of the Class Action
4 Settlement in this matter on March 2, 2020.

5 WHEREAS the deadline to submit a claim for compensation was May 28, 2020, and the
6 settlement compensation program is now closed.

7 WHEREAS at least 34,082 Settlement Class Members filed claims for individual
8 compensation through the Settlement, and all valid, complete and timely claims have been paid.
9 ECF 7892.

10 WHEREAS the approved Settlement Agreement provides that: "[i]f there are any funds
11 remaining in the Settlement Value after all valid, complete, and timely Claims are paid, subject to
12 Court approval, the balance will be directed to environmental remediation efforts."

13 WHEREAS Class Plaintiffs, with the support of Defendants, have proposed a plan to
14 distribute the remaining balance in the Settlement Fund to environmental remediation efforts
15 through various recipients and projects detailed in the proposal.

16 WHEREAS information about the proposed recipients and projects has been made
17 available to Class Members and the public via the Settlement Website.

18 Having reviewed and considered Plaintiffs' proposal, the Court hereby APPROVES the
19 proposal and directs that the remaining Settlement Value in this matter be distributed to the
20 environmental remediation recipients and projects set forth in Class Plaintiffs' submission.
